## FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

Dear Friends,

I bring you greetings from the South England Conference.

We met as Pastors and were inspired by the many activities taking place around the Conference under our theme, **Making Disciples and Building Communities**. It was particularly encouraging to hear how church members have embraced the concept and are engaging in Discovery Bible Reading with work colleagues, friends, and family members. This inclusive and non-intimidating Bible study method is proving very effective and achieving great results.

In some areas pastors have discovered that evangelistic campaigns are not yielding the results that we used to see in the past. Increasingly, we seem to be preaching to ourselves. However, when members meet in small groups and embark on the discipleship track, greater results are achieved. The Holy Spirit is not only working on the hearts of those we are discipling, but He is also transforming our hearts.

Our church communities continue to perform acts of kindness, and this is impacting local residents. New relationships are being formed, creating opportunities to share the gospel of Jesus Christ.

The car struck a kerb and his hand accidentally hit the controls of the radio, tuning it to Adventist Radio London. There he listened to a presentation on the love of Jesus and His sacrifice on the cross. The Holy Spirit touched his heart and the young man asked himself, "who is He that is talking to me?"

At the end of the presentation, he called Pastor Mike Hamilton who was the host presenter. Pastor Hamilton referred him to a local minister, Pastor John Melki, who studied with him and rejoiced when the young man decided to give his life to Christ. He is planning to be baptised next month and is already engaged in sharing his testimony and helping through acts of kindness to build his community.
