



FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

Brothers and sisters,

I greet you in the name of our Lord.

I was thrilled to read about God's blessing among the Romanian Churches. Last Sabbath, Pastors Bogdan Dumitru and Gabriel Ciocarlan baptised 13 candidates at the Stanborough Park Church. Two others were baptised the Sabbath before and another two will be baptised shortly, making a total of 17. All these precious souls came to faith as a result of Bible study on the zoom platform. To God be the glory!

Friends as we continue with our theme **Making Disciples and Building Communities**, let us never undervalue the power of the Discovery Bible Studies. This is a powerful tool where the Holy Spirit works on the hearts of individuals bringing conviction and leading them to give their lives to Jesus.

Another church that has been very successful with Bible Studies is the Portsmouth Church. They have likewise had several baptisms during the pandemic. I was very impressed when their minister, Pastor Elliott Williams shared with me an exercise carried out by their church Board called **Portsmouth SDA Church Emergency Protocol.**

We were all taken by surprise by the recent corona virus pandemic. What have we learned as a result of the past 2 years? What things can we put in place in preparation should we experience another pandemic? As Adventists, we have read about the final crisis and the need to prepare for it. However, have we as local congregations sat and discussed what we will do? And how we will go about making those preparations?

This congregation have come up with some practical suggestions of what can be done to prepare for another pandemic and the final crisis. I asked Pastor Williams for permission to share this with the larger conference family which he agreed. Pastors, you may also choose to do a similar exercise for your local congregation.

Portsmouth SDA Church Emergency Protocol

Considering what we have learnt from the current Coronavirus pandemic, it would be unwise to be caught off guard again by making little to no preparation for national/global crisis. We need a warning system to alert members to the degree of threat we face: Traffic light system Green: Safe Amber: Start preparing Red: Implement action plan 1.Pandemics Coronavirus will not be the last pandemic in our lifetime. Scientists warn the threat posed by zoonoses - infectious diseases that jump from animals to humans - is on the rise. • The church board should carry out a risk assessment to ensure that they are providing as safe an environment as possible for our members and end-users to worship in and use. It is important that the risk assessment is continually reviewed by the church board and currently this should be done at least quarterly.

• If it is unsafe to meet at Church then meetings should be held virtually.

• All members should be regularly reminded what the symptoms of Covid-19 or the prevailing pandemic are and reminded to remain at home and join the service virtually.

• Facemasks and any recommended protective equipment should be worn by everyone except those who are exempt under the previous or prevailing guidelines.

Facilities for hand sanitising should be readily available at all our services and programmes

• Where possible venues should be well ventilated during use, following prevailing safety rules and regulations

PPE should still be provided for all volunteers

• 'Zoning' spaces to be considered if the building is big enough, to allow those who wish to continue to socially distance to do so.

In doing this it will be important to consider how people enter and leave the building, as well as ensuring that different areas of the building have equal access to the service or events they are attending, and especially that people are not disadvantaged by their desire to continue to show caution.

Providing those wishing to maintain social distance with cards to put next to them when sat down, asking people to leave the seats next to them free.

Amber: Start preparing

Alert our members to stock up with household goods/ toiletries and other essentials relevant to each family situation. Dry food - cans, rice, etc Medical supplies, masks etc Check on our vulnerable who may need help or advice with stocking up. Our members are encouraged to buy as many of these items as quickly as possible and to advise others where to find stocks in

case of shortages:

- Water filters
- Canned foods (stews, fruit, tuna, beans, meats, etc)
- Ready-to-eat foods (granola, cheese, protein bars, etc)
- Medical kits
- Peanut butter
- Assorted drink mixes, (if you have children with you)
- Multi-vitamins
- Iodine solution, hydrogen peroxide, painkillers
- Dried milk
- Largest bags of rice, beans, flour, oats, sugar and honey
- Gallons of cooking oil
- Baking powder & baking soda & spice assortment pack
- A manual can opener
- Kitchen matches and disposable lighters
- Sanitary napkins and diapers, if needed
- Flashlights (ideally LED) and portable •
- radios, if you don't already have them Plenty more batteries, at least three
- sets, for each of the above Bottled water (especially if home supplies not secured yet)
- Baby wipes
- (Please note this is not an exhaustive list)
