HISTORY OF THE STOKE NEWINGTON SEVENTH DAY ADVENTIST CHURCH 1964-1999

The Stoke Newington Seventh-day Adventist Church can trace its roots from its humble beginnings in the home of Brother and Sister Noel Ashley at Mildenhall Road Clapton. It was there that Bible study and prayer meeting took place. This fledgling group, drawn from the Holloway SDA Church and the New Gallery Centre soon grew large enough to seek alternative accomadation. God led them to The Friends Meeting House at Yoakley Road, Stoke Newington. A request was made to the Conference for a pastor, and this company was placed under the pastoral care of the late Pastor Nicholson.

By the 1st January 1966 with 60 members the Stoke Newington SDA Church was organised. Brother Ashley was ordained first elder and was assisted by Brother Robertson and Brother Gumms. In 1973 the Friends Meeting House was purchased for £40,000. The church grew steadily over the years, however it experience dramatic growth under the ministerial leadership of the late Pastor and Sister Theodore McLeary. During this period some needful alterations were made to the interior of the building to accommodate the growing congregation. The youth hall was also built to facilitate youth activities, and was later developed into a youth church under the leadership of Pastor Hugo Kennedy. Many of the young people received training and have developed into the leaders of today's church, and we are proud of them.

Evangelism was the main thrust, and as the membership grew it was deemed necessary to launch into new territory. In 1977 the Hackney company was formed in Haggerston Road, Hackney and was organised into a church soon after. In 1982 the Clapton Company was also formed and is now an organised church. After the birth of these daughters there was still need to expand the existing building. In 1987 the vacant land around the building was purchased from the Friends Society, and an extension was built to the cost of £330,000. In September 1999 the last repayment was made on the mortgage and now the church is debt free.

September 5th 1993, marked the historical event of the first wedding in Stokey, that of Bro. & Sis. Hand, conducted by Pastor R. Holder. As the beautiful bride and the handsome groom walked down the aisle the guests captured the moment with joyful delight. Since that grand day, Stokey became the venue for many weddings.
